Blackjack Tournament Rules

1. The Blackjack Tournament is limited to the first 30 participants.
2. The tournament players will be playing with tokens, not casino chips or money.
3. Each player shall receive a preset number of chips for their \$10 buy-in.
4. Players do not get to keep chips or any other “winnings” other than the designated Grand Prize.
5. Play will take place in a series of “heats”.
6. The order of play shall be determined by a random drawing prior to the start of the tournament.
7. Each heat will last a minimum of 10 minutes. The total number of players participating in the tournament will determine the actual duration of each heat as well as the duration of the final round.
8. No hands will be dealt after the time limit has expired. However, if play has commenced when time expires the round of play will continue.
9. The player with the most winnings from each heat will advance to the final round.
10. Players advancing to the final round will again start with a preset number of chips.
11. The player with the most winnings from the final round will be the winner of the Grand Prize.
12. In case of a tie after any heat or the final round the winner shall be determined by a cut of the playing deck. The player drawing the highest card shall be declared the winner.
13. The Organizing Committee, or their designee, shall be the sole body responsible for determining any disputes and their decision shall be final.

Payment: Payment in full is due at time of booking. Payment may be made by check or online via PayPal. Your documents will be sent approximately two weeks prior to the event.

Cancellations Up to 21 days prior, you may cancel without any penalty. From 21 days to 7 days prior, you may cancel your package with a cancellation penalty of \$130 per person for banqueting and service charges. 1. By execution of this Waiver and Indemnity Agreement, I/We acknowledge my/our participation in the 2007 West Coast BoxsterFest. I further agree that my/our participation in this event is voluntary and conditioned upon my/our execution of this Waiver and Indemnity Agreement. (For purposes of clarity, all pronouns are hereafter stated in the singular but the singular encompasses the plural.)
2. I understand that volunteers that meet on the Internet through various websites arrange this event. I know that this event is not sponsored, endorsed by, or associated with any website even though some or all of the owners, operators, deputies and others may be present at the event.
3. I further know and understand that the event is not sponsored by, endorsed or associated with any dealer, any tire manufacturer, Porsche Cars North America or Porsche A.G. I agree that should a dealer or other person offer prizes, gifts or emoluments to participants in this event, such does not constitute sponsorship, endorsement of or association with this event.
4. I agree and understand that the volunteers that are arranging this event do so without making any warranty or representation as to the suitability of road conditions or that my Porsche will be able to navigate the roads, bridges, low water crossings, driveways, parking lots and other unusual driving conditions where the event may be conducted.
